

Rules for visitors

All visitors are welcome to Tehran Art exhibition. To ensure your safety and having a rich experience during your visit, please mind the following rules:

- During the exhibition, several press and photography events will be held by professionals. Please be advised that admittance in the exhibition you accept that your pictures and films may be taken by the press professionals.
- Professional photography devices (including but not limited to DSR cameras, professional lenses, flashes, monopods, tripods, etc.), as well as any filming devices (like professional recording cameras, handicap, etc.). Visitors may use amateur devices (such as cellphones and compact cameras) at booths, only by the explicit permission of the exhibitor.
- All baggages/carriages larger than 35.35 centimeters must be handed over to the designated storage place at check-in hall .
- No backpacks of any size are allowed. Also, smaller bags that are allowed into the house will be subjected to inspection at the entrance and may be subjected to further inspection during visit.
- Pets are not allowed in the exhibition halls.
- Guards and other security personnel are to protect artworks. Please respect their instructions.
- The whole space of Tehran Art is friendly for handicapped.

Helpful hints for visiting with children

- Encourage your children not to run in the exhibits and booths.
- Children can be brought in baby strolls.
- Children - as well as adults – are not allowed to touch artworks as their natural skin fat may damage the artworks.
- Remind children that guards and other security personnel are present to protect artworks from thief and/or damages. Please ask your children to respect their instructions.
- To protect the artworks, having foods and drinks are not allowed in the designated areas (including dining and cafes).
- Children under age 16 must always be accompanied by an adult.
